ELP PBIS focuses on preventative, teaching, and consequential strategies to create a safe and meaningful learning environment. Modeling behaviors and the development of relationships with the students of ELP are crucial to the success of implementing PBIS. The following will supplement this process:

*EXAMPLE: (PROPOSED IDEA) Each program leader will award one student a day with a bead. By awarding this bead to that student, the program leader is recognizing that the student has displayed one or more of the High-five qualities and met the expectations associated with them.*

- 1 BEAD PER DAY; AT ANY POINT IN THE DAY
